

Grant Parish Public Schools Transportation Release Form

Grant Parish Public Schools follow all state laws, rules and guidelines for dropping off students at bus stops. When dropping off students that are in elementary school, bus drivers must be able to see an adult (parent, guardian or designated person) either at the bus stop or at the student's residence. If an adult or designated person is not present, the bus driver may be instructed to return the student to the school after the route and/or place the student in the custody of our resource officer. For Pre-K through 3rd Grade students, transportation will be suspended five (5) days for the third occurrence, ten (10) days for the fourth occurrence and for the remainder of the year on the fifth occurrence.

HOWEVER:

The Grant Parish School Board does not recommend leaving elementary students unsupervised, however, if you want your elementary child dropped off at your residence without a parent, guardian or designated person present, please complete and sign the form below and return to your child's driver by _____.

By signing below, I verify that I **DO NOT** want a parent, guardian, or designated person present when my child is dropped off and that I have made arrangements. I understand that I am completely responsible for my child's safe entry to our residence without supervision.
