The Grant Parish School Board having ownership of three surplus maintenance vehicles intends to offer them for sale at public auction.

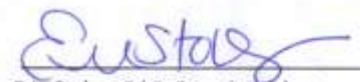
WHEREAS, the vehicles are listed as follows:
