Districtwide Technology / Chromebook Usage Fee

Grant Parish School Board provides each student with a Chromebook for school-related use during the 2026-2027 school year. A \$30 Technology/Chromebook Usage Fee is required in order for a student to use a district Chromebook.

This fee helps cover Chromebook maintenance and use during the school year. It is not an insurance fee. Any major damage that makes a device irreparable may require the parent or guardian to cover replacement costs. If a loaner Chromebook is issued and damaged due to misuse or neglect, the parent or guardian may be responsible for repair costs.

Chromebooks remain the property of the Grant Parish School Board and are loaned to students for school-related work only.
