

Athletic programs in Grant Parish are primarily for student participants. The purpose of this activity is to provide positive learning experiences and personal growth of the participants.

We are pleased to host our visitors. This program is being conducted according to the rules of the Grant Parish School Activities Association. Cheerleaders, officials, and spectators can, and are expected to, assist in promoting and achieving good sportsmanship ideals by taking personal responsibility for keeping the contest at a high level of fair, clean, wholesome competition. In order to ensure athletic events support a safe and friendly environment, the following protocols will be followed at all athletic events in Grant Parish.

SAFETY & SECURITY PROCEDURES

Entrance to Events

- A. Guests will pass through designated areas and will pass through weapon detectors prior to entrance. Designated areas will be identified with signage. The School Board reserves the right to inspect or search at any time any facilities, objects, or vehicles on the school campus. Random searches with a weapons detector and/or metal detector of a person or his/her personal effects may be conducted.
- B. Any item that could be used as a weapon is NOT allowed. Examples include but are not limited to firearms, knives, other sharp objects, mace, etc. Items will be confiscated and not returned.
- C. Guests are discouraged from bringing any bags into athletic facilities. If bags are brought into facilities, they must adhere to the listed guidelines below.

Bag Guidelines



Clear Plastic or Vinyl Bags

No larger than 12 x 6 x 12.



One-Gallon Clear Plastic Freezer Bag

Must be clear plastic.



Small Clutch Bags

No larger than 4.5 x 6.5; approximately the size of a hand, with or without a handle or strap.



Medically Necessary Items

Allowed after proper inspection at the entrance.



Diaper Bags

Allowed with an infant/toddler and after proper inspection at the entrance.



Inspection Required

All bags and approved exceptions are subject to inspection.

EVENT PROTOCOLS

- A. Grant Parish Schools are a Tobacco Free Zone. The use of tobacco products including but not limited to cigarettes, e-cigarettes, cigars, and smokeless tobacco is prohibited. Citations may be given for underage tobacco use.
- B. No outside food or beverages should be brought into the event. Exceptions will be made for one 32-ounce or smaller factory-sealed water bottle.
- C. No one will be allowed to re-enter the event after leaving. Anyone entering the event must have a new, unused ticket to enter.
- D. Audio and video surveillance cameras may be in use and identified by signage.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- A. Elementary and Middle School students must be accompanied by an adult. All students should have transportation arranged and be picked up in a timely manner. Guests should remain seated and not horseplay, run, or play in off-limit areas.
- B. All guests are expected to sit in the bleachers. No spectators are allowed on the track, field, or court before, during, or after the game.
- C. No fighting allowed. All offenders will be removed immediately by school officials, subject to arrest by the Grant Parish Sheriff's Office, and any necessary disciplinary action by the school.
- D. Any Grant Parish student currently serving suspension (ISS or OSS) or expelled from a Grant Parish School is not permitted to attend school events and may be removed immediately without a refund.
- E. School Administration reserves the right to deny entry and/or remove anyone. Please be courteous and aware of those around you. That includes refraining from loud conversations, disrespect toward players, coaches, and officials, or engaging in otherwise inappropriate behavior. All individuals who refuse to comply with the school officials' directions will be immediately escorted from the stadium, will not be allowed re-admittance, and may be banned from attending future school events for the remainder of the school year.
